

DR. MICHAEL FULLAN

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Dr. Michael Fullan is the former Dean of the Ontario Institute for Studies in Education of the University of Toronto. Recognized as an international authority on educational reform, Dr. Fullan is engaged in training, consulting and evaluating change projects around the world. He led the evaluation team that conducted the four-year assessment of the National Literacy and Numeracy Strategy in England from 1998-2003. In April 2004, Dr. Fullan was appointed Special Advisor to the Premier and Minister of Education in Ontario.

An innovator and leader in teacher education, Dr. Fullan has developed a number of partnerships designed to bring about major school improvement and educational reform. He participates as researcher, consultant, trainer and policy advisor on a wide range of educational change projects with school systems, teachers' federations, research and development institutes and government agencies in Canada and internationally. Dr. Fullan has been published widely on the topic of educational change. His most recent books include *Turnaround Leadership; the New Meaning of Educational Change*, 3rd Edition; and *Leading in a Culture of Change*. Dr. Fullan has also published *Change Forces: The Sequel*; *Change Forces: Probing the Depths of Educational Reform*; and the *What's Worth Fighting For* series.
